Go to <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>.

Log in with the student's FSA ID and password. If you are a new user filling out the FAFSA for the first time this academic year, click "Start Here."

- If you are a returning user, having started the FAFSA, saved but not yet submitted it, select "Log in." Then, select "Make FAFSA Correction" and click Next.

Select the "Financial Information" section from the menu bar at the top of the page.

This is the 2021-2022 "Parent Tax Filing Status" view.

Parents who filed amended tax returns are eligible to use the IRS DRT. However, because the IRS is unable to transmit amended tax information, data transferred from the IRS into FAFSA will be the original tax information. Please be aware if you amended your taxes and use the DRT process, you may be asked for additional documentation by the Student Financial Planning office.

- You will be asked if you have completed your 2019 IRS Income Tax Return. You must be able to select "Already Completed" to continue.
- You will be asked the following question: Did you (or your parents) file a Puerto Rican or foreign tax return for 2019? You must be able to answer No to this question to proceed.
- If eligible, click "Link to the IRS."



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2021-2022 “Parent Login to the IRS DRT” view.

This is a new view asking which parent will be accessing the IRS DRT.

- Select which parent is entering the information and then enter the FSA ID and password for that parent

Students will be able to access the data retrieval process without the FSA ID and password if entered at login, otherwise it will need to be entered on this page.

- Click “Proceed to IRS Site”

You will receive a prompt stating you are now leaving FAFSA on the Web.

- Click OK



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You will receive another prompt stating that you are now using and entering a U.S. Government website.

- Click OK

- Review the prefilled information and make sure that the first name, last name, social security number and date of birth are correct
- Select the appropriate filing status if not filled in
- Enter the address EXACTLY as it is shown on your tax return (word for word, abbreviation for abbreviation, any punctuation (such as a period) after abbreviation, case sensitive)
- Select “Submit.”
- Please note that you have 3 attempts to enter this information. If you do not move to the next screen after you enter your information for the first time, you will have 2 attempts left. Double-check your information to make sure it matches your tax return.



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If the information matches and can be transferred, you will now see a summary page of the information that will be transferred into the FAFSA

- Scroll to the bottom of the page.
- Check the box to the left of the “Transfer Data to FAFSA” options.
- Select “Transfer Now.”

Based on the information you provided, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) located your income tax return. With your permission below, the IRS will securely transfer your tax information to the U.S. Department of Education (ED) to populate any applicable FAFSA® questions.

The tax information provided to fafsa.gov will populate the answers to the appropriate FAFSA questions. After the FAFSA questions are populated, your IRS session will end, and you will return to your FAFSA form. Check this box if you are choosing to transfer your information.

By clicking the “Do Not Transfer” button, you are choosing not to transfer your tax information electronically. Your IRS session will end, and you will return to your FAFSA form.
